CONTEST RULES AND ENTRY FORM ARE BELOW

For Artwork:

- Fulfill the overall size specifications of 12 inch x 18 inch
- Conform to the vertical axis (Posters should not be drawn on the horizontal axis)
- Have the entry blank filled out completely and clearly. (Glue it to the back securely)
- List age, grade and school (homeschool) on entry blank
- Use free-hand drawn letters only (No stenciled, traced, preprinted or press-on letters may be used)
- Express your own original art work (**POSTER DESIGNS MAY NOT USE COMIC AND/OR TV CHARACTERS, PHOTOGRAPHS, NEWSPAPER OR MAGAZINE ILLUSTRATIONS.**)

For Photography:

- Photos must be taken by student and be high resolution (300 dpi or higher)
- All photos must be a minimum size of 8 inch x 10 inch
- Have the entry blank filled out completely and clearly (Glue it to the back securely)
- If the photo is emailed, please make sure the student's name, grade, age, parent/guardian and school are added to the body of the email.
- Emailed photos should be sent to parksandrec@westerville.org with subject line *"2018 Arbor Day Poster Contest"*

Other Submission Rules:

- All entries must express the slogan theme in a positive way
- All entries must be wrapped flat - not rolled or in tubes
- **ONLY ONE ENTRY PER STUDENT**
